# **Chemistry in Art**

Purchased tools, materials, and equipment to be used in a new semester course offered at SME that integrates art with science.

#### **Code HS**

Purchased the Pro version of this Computer Science software for additional curriculum, teaching tools and more.

## **World Language Readers**

Purchased leveled chapter books and magazines for French and Spanish students to help increase language proficiency through reading. This included teacher guides as well as access to supplemental video and audio.

## **KUTA Software**

Purchased three years of the KUTA software license for Math teachers to generate worksheets and practice tests for students needing intervention. This software used to be included in the District budget, but is no longer, and the entire math department can use it.

# **Visiting Artist**

Paid for updates and maintenance to the Crawford Gallery.
Funded a visiting resident artist who works with students and also curates an exhibit.

#### **Personalized PE**

Provided funding for equipment to modify games and activities to accommodate students with varying levels of abilities. The new Personalized PE course integrates both special education and general education students in a physical education setting.

## **Link Coordinator Training**

Funded training for two of the four Link Crew Coordinators to help meet their goals of improving their selection process, better integrating leadership skills within training, and how to best to have Link Crew do follow-up visits with 9<sup>th</sup> graders.

# **Privacy Pods**

Purchased one 2-person pod and two 4-person pods that were installed in the library and set up with tables and chairs. They will serve a variety of purposes including a place for journalism students to conduct interviews, teachers to make phone calls, students to complete testing and many more.
